The Beadle Program is a ministry of College Church of the Nazarene intended to build and strengthen a healthy support system for single mothers and their children.

This program includes financial, physical, and emotional support for participant families from a spiritual perspective.

The program is designed to be molded to the specific needs of each family, to help connect each family to the people and/or programs that will allow them to reach their goals.

individual's current situations and needs are defined, and primary goals are developed into a plan of action for each family. The action plan is intended to help them gain life skills that will provide personal, financial and social responsibilities for themselves and their families. As part of the program, Beadle provides housing for up to two years for single mothers and their children with rent and utilities provided. Each participant is expected to communicate regularly with the Resident Directors to review the action plan in working toward the family's goals.

### BENEFITS AND CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:

Spiritual development through weekly church, Bible Study, and ministry opportunities.

- ☒ Participate in Beadle Program according to an individual family plan.
- ☒ Rent and utilities provided for up to two years.
- ☒ No alcohol or drug use or possession; agree to initial and random drug/alcohol screens.
- ☒ No overnight guests without pre-approval. Co-habitation is not permitted.
- ☒ Agree to develop a financial plan with a financial advisor and to disclose personal income, expenses, and savings as necessary for financial accountability.
- ☒ Agree to diligent care and maintenance of the guest-housing unit.
- ☒ Agree to other housing limits such as no pets and no smoking.
